All Medalta Replica and Hycroft Original items will be 10% off. Paintings by the Mad Hatters of the Brush & Palette, Altglass and high-quality, local pottery will also be on display and available for purchase.

In addition to the sale, hourly demonstrations will take place in the Working Pottery, providing visitors with the opportunity to meet the craftspeople and see how the items in the gift shop are made.

Refreshments will be served and there are door prizes to be won. Entry to the Historic Clay District museum is free for the day. This is a great opportunity for people to find a unique, one-of-a-kind gift.

The Historic Clay District is one of eight attractors in the Canadian Badlands, is featured in AMA's "Alberta 100 Journeys" and is Western Canada's largest National Historic Site. The District museum – in the Medalta Potteries National Historic Site – provides visitors a unique opportunity to visit a restored 1912 pottery factory, which once produced three-quarters of all stoneware in Canada. It is operated under the stewardship of the Friends of Medalta Society.
