

BRIDGING HERITAGE AND INNOVATION

The Friends of Medalta Society (Medalta) operates an industrial heritage museum, two National Historic Sites, and three Provincial Historic Resources in Medicine Hat, Alberta, Canada. Working from a mixed economy business model, this once-static museum has been transformed into a dynamic facility that activates the community and inspires change. Our museum campus results from a dedicated restoration effort over many years and provides a stunning context for our programming.



Our award-winning education program is an innovative, experiential, cross-curricular learning model that moves student learning "beyond the classroom" into the Historic Clay District. We provide cultural and educational immersion that engages students in inquiry-based learning and exploration through a host of creative, integrated activities. We create pottery that is sold throughout Canada. We use original factory equipment and materials from within a 100-kilometer radius. Additionally, our firing process utilizes energy extracted from beneath our facility. Our Artist-in-Residence program attracts artists from around the world to our community to conduct engaging research in a proximal learning environment.

With an emphasis on material, The Friends of Medalta Society takes lessons from its industrial & entrepreneurial past and aligns them with social, artistic, and educational priorities to create an enriching, relevant and forward-thinking cultural organization that engages a local, regional, and international audience.

- 3. Increase pottery skill demonstrations and create interactive opportunities for museum visitors
- 4. Continue development of the Medicine Hat Potteries/Hycroft site and promote the project through the redevelopment of the National Porcelain site in accordance with Medalta's Long-Term Plan

We will know that we are making progress on achieving our Heritage goal when:

- Our number of returning visitors grows
- Our facilities are barrier-free and inclusive
- Our site development plans are moving forward



INTERNATIONAL ARTIST IN RESIDENCE PROGRAM

PROVIDE FACILITIES AND PROGRAMS FOR ARTISTS TO WORK IN AN IMMERSIVE ENVIRONMENT, AMONG A COMMUNITY OF CERAMIC ARTISTS, WHERE THEY CAN DEVOTE THEMSELVES TO DISCOVERY, SKILL DEVELOPMENT, CREATIVITY, AND ARTISTRY.





Objectives

- 1. Establish a funding model to reinstate an Artistic Director position
- 2. Engage the Medalta International Artist in Residence (MIAIR) alumni community through programming, conferences, thematic residencies, and events
- 3. Expand the rental offerings of the Shaw International Centre for Contemporary Ceramics facilities and equipment
- **4.** Explore the acquisition of emergent digital technologies and required facility expansion
- Create a strategy and funding model for evergreening kilns and ceramics equipment, including computers and related information technology (IT)
- 6. Explore the development of indoor and outdoor spaces for the comfort and to build community among artists in residence and alumni of the MIAIR programs
- 7. Create opportunities and seek funding to offer MIAIR programs to under-represented communities
- 8. Develop/renovate MIAIR facilities to be barrier-free

We will know we are making progress on achieving our MIAIR goal when:

- We have engaged an Artistic Director to lead MIAIR programming
- When rental revenue from the use of Shaw Centre for Contemporary Ceramics facilities and equipment grows
- When we have a plan to introduce the acquisition and use of emergent technologies in MIAIR programs
- When our development plans include expansion of MIAIR facilities that are linked to MIAIR program growth and sustainability
- When plans are in place to ensure all MIAIR facilities are accessible work on making facilities accessible has begun
- When Alumni are reconnected with MIAIR and are actively participating in new programming and events
